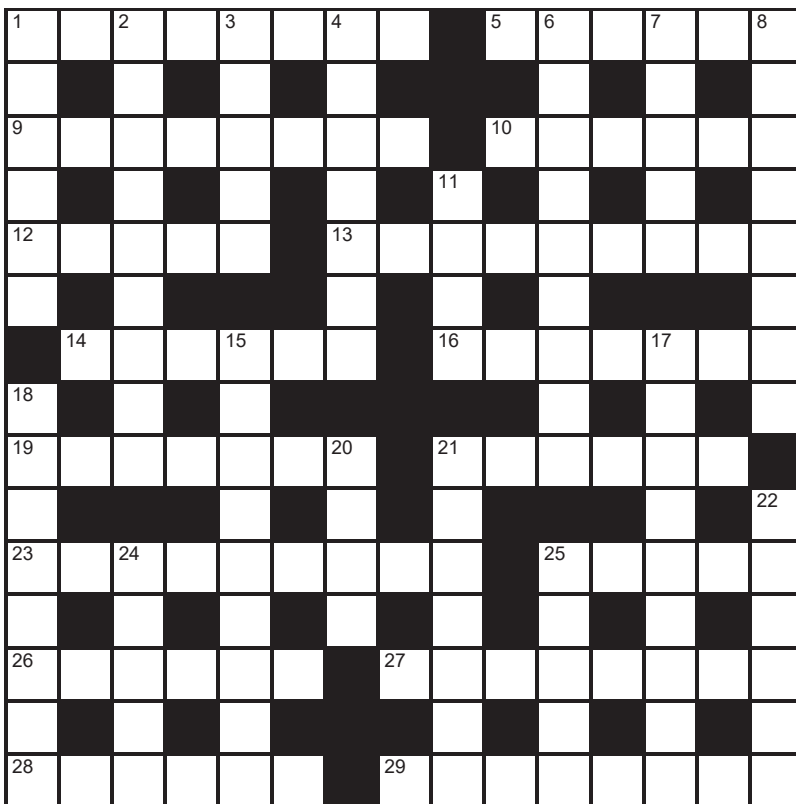


CROSSWORD No 18,217 by GOLIATH
